### RE: POSTPONMENT OF THE NORTH EAST REGION ELECTION FOR DELEGATES TO THE FUFA GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The FUFA Electoral Committee is in receipt of a petition dated 29<sup>th</sup> April 2025 citing incidents of alleged voter intimidation in the lead-up to the elections of the North Eastern region delegates to the FUFA general assembly scheduled for **30<sup>th</sup> April 2025**.

The petitioner cited an environment that may not guarantee the principles of a free, fair, and transparent electoral process.

The Electoral Committee takes such allegations seriously, as they go to the heart of the FUFA Electoral Committee's commitment to democratic principles and the integrity of its electoral process. In accordance with the FUFA Electoral Code and Electoral Guidelines the Committee is currently conducting a review of the petition to determine its merits and the appropriate course of action.

In view of the above; this is to notify the relevant persons that the election mentioned herein above is hereby **postponed until further notice**.

We wish to assure all stakeholders that:

1. The Electoral Committee is committed to ensuring that all eligible voters are able to exercise their rights without fear or intimidation.
2. Consultations with relevant authorities, including internal legal bodies and security organs, are underway to verify the credibility of the claims raised.

In the meantime, the Committee urges all parties to remain calm, desist from any acts that may further compromise the electoral environment, and allow the due process to take its course.
