Greetings from the FUFA Secretariat;

Human resource capacity building is a fundamental programme in the deployment of trained personnel for the successful implementation of the FUFA Technical Master Plan.

FUFA defines the following terminologies as follows: -

- Football Educators:** These shall be the resourceful persons who shall impart and transfer skills and knowledge to Trainers in the programme of Training of Trainers (ToT).
- Football Instructors:** These shall be the resourceful individuals responsible for imparting and transferring skills and knowledge to Football Teachers, Coaches, Trainers, Specialists and their assistants in the programme of Training of Students (ToS).
- Coaches:** These shall be the resourceful individuals responsible for imparting and transferring both practical and theoretical skills and knowledge to players as the end user.
- Teachers:** These shall be the resourceful individuals responsible for imparting and transferring theoretical skills and knowledge to players as the end users.
- Trainers:** These shall be the resourceful individuals responsible for imparting and transferring practical skills and knowledge to players as the end users
- Specialists:** These shall be the resourceful individuals responsible for providing specialised services to support the Coach.

Some Football Educators may also work as Instructors.

The Football Instructors shall be categorised as follows:
